

NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

The Organizing Authority (OA) is Fishers Island Yacht Club (FIYC). The host Club is FIYC.

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between rules or regulations, other than RRS, the sailing instructions will prevail. This changes RRS 63.7.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (Sis)

Sailing instructions will be available on June 22 online on the official notice board.

3 COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 The official notice board is located at Fishers Island Yacht Club and on the event website (phlotilla.com)
- 3.2 All competing boats are strongly encouraged to carry a handheld VHF radio for safety purposes and race committee communications.
- 3.3 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.
- 3.4 The race committee intends to use VHF marine radio frequencies to broadcast courtesy information to competitors. The race committee's VHF channel will be stated in the Sis.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Summer Series is open to all boats of the following class(es): International One Design (IOD) and Bullseye.
- 4.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing and submitting the online entry form through the event website located at phlotilla.com.

5 ENTRY FEES

There are no entry fees to register and compete in the Summer Series, except for those fees required by the organizers of the Fishers Island Round the Island Race.

6 ADVERTISING

Competitor advertising will not be restricted.

7 SERIES

- 7.1 Monthly Series shall be conducted in July, and August, according to the schedule of races in Section 8.2.
- 7.2 The Summer Series will consist of the July Series and August Series.
- 7.3 For the IODs, the Qualifying Series are outlined in the Fishers Island IOD Fleet Rules, available at <http://iodwca.org/fleets/fishers-island> (click on BY LAWS) with 2021 modification for the Nantucket qualifier as shown in NOR 8.2. This will also be posted on the official notice board.

8 SCHEDULE

8.3 It is the intention of the Race Committee to run three (3) W/L races per day for the IODs and 2 races for the Bullseyes with a mix of W/L and navigator courses.

8.4 No warning signal will be made after 4:00pm.

9 VENUE

Racing will be held in the waters of Fishers Island Sound.

10 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will generally be windward-leeward courses and navigator courses, with the exception of the E. Burr 'Round Sound Race and the Trophy Races, which will be "navigator's races."

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

US Sailing Prescription Appendix V1 - PENALTY AT THE TIME OF AN INCIDENT, will apply.

12 SCORING

12.1 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

12.2 (a) When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from four (4) to seven (7) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. (c) When eight (8) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12.3 OCS, DSQ and DNF will be scored as last place plus one based on the number of competitors starting the race. DNC and DNS will be scored based on the number of competitors in the relevant monthly series plus one.

12.4 A boat's score in the Summer Series will consist of the sum of her scores in each of the July and August Series. A boat that does not participate in any one of the July and/or August series will be scored DNC for purposes of calculating their score for the Summer Series.

13 RISK STATEMENT AND DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Summer Series entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, DECISION TO RACE. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Summer Series.

14 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. Each skipper is liable for any and all damages and personal liability. Proof of insurance shall be provided upon request.

15 PRIZES

15.1 Prizes will be given to the top three boats in each class for each of the July Series, August Series and Summer Series.

15.2 Trophies will also be awarded for: July 4 Trophy Race, FIYC Round Island Race, and Labor Day Trophy Race.
